



Sevenoaks Gospel Trust – Cookie Notice

Cookies are small pieces of data stored on a site visitor's browser, usually used to keep track of their movements and actions on a site. There are two types of cookies:

- Session (Transient) cookies: These cookies are erased when you close your browser, and do not collect information from your computer. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.
- Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies: These cookies are stored on your hard drive until they expire (i.e. they are based on a set expiration date) or until you delete them. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as user preferences for a specific site.

The table below lists the cookies which Wix (our website host) places on its sites.

Please note that Sevenoaks Gospel Trust does not use any of the information collected by cookies on our website – these are purely there for the correct functioning of the site.

Cookie name	Life span	Purpose
svSession	Persistent	Identifies unique visitors and tracks a visitor's sessions on a site
hs	Session	Security
XSRF-TOKEN	Session	Security
smSession	Persistent (Two weeks)	Identifies logged in site members
TSxxxxxxx (where x is replaced with a random series of numbers and letters)	Session	Security
TSxxxxxxx_d (where x is replaced with a random series of numbers and letters)	Session	Security
RequestID	Session	Track visitor behavior and measure site performance
